## June Jesters Autotest - 24th June 1984.

As mentioned briefly last month, marshals are required for this, hopefully prestigious, event which is a round of the RAC British Championship, the BTRDA Autotest Championship and the ANCC Autotest Championship for the Yorkshire Bank Trophy. All volunteers should contact the Chief Marshal, Tonnie Moore.

The event takes place at Pudsey Civic Hall car park (nap ref. 104 /211347) and the action starts at 10.30 an (marshals required by 10.00 an or carlier). The emphasis should be on ACTION as those of you who have not witnessed an autotest of this status will surely have their eyes opened by the skill of many of the drivers. As an added attraction, the tests will be run'in tanden'. i.e. two identical tests side by side with cars starting simultaneously — it all adds to the exitement!

Further, during the lunch break there will be a "Buggytest" for radio controlled, electric powered buggies or whatever, belonging to competitors/ marshals / officials or their proven relatives. So, if you have one bring it along - there's a pot for the winner +CASH and cash for 2nd. Entries, on the day, are restricted to ten or so - entry fee for FOUR tests is £1.00.

There's more ..... All marshals / officials who sign on will be entered into the marshals draw. Cash prizes of £7 and £3 to the 1st and 2nd out of the hat with the possibility of a 3rd prize,, as yet undisclosed. These not present at the draw will forfeit their prize!!

Still nore ..... We are grateful to Mr. Ralph Porter and his staff at the Pudsey Civic Hall for making the venue available to us and he is opening the bar in the civic hall between 12.00 and 2.00 pm. - We're sure you wen't need any encouraging to take advantage of this facility! Also, there will be a catering van on the site all day.

## PROPHY POINTS SCORING SYSTEM - REGULATIONS

You must be a full member of Trackrod Motor Club Ltd. and enter under Trackrod MC to qualify for any Trackrod award. The year starts on January 1st and finishes on december 31st. I must have all results in for Mecember 31st, after this date they will not count. (With the exception of events that run over the Christmas period, upto Jan. 1st. Please notify no by phone if competing or officiating BEFORE the event).

For claiming points, results must be in to the trophy points Secretary within one month of their publication, with the exceptions as above.

## 1. Rally & Speed Shop Trophy, Autotests Donor Mr. & Mrs. White Also Autotost Runners Up Trophy

Only Trackrod events to count for this trophy. Scoring as follows:-

11 points Fastest time of the day 1st in each class 10 Down to 5th in class 6 All other finishers All non-finishers

## 2. P.C.T. Trophy Donor Mr. & Mrs. Dickinson

Only Trackrod events to count for this trophy. Scoring same as Rally & Speed Autotest trophy system.

## 3. Marshals Trophy

Every event you marshal on, rallies, autotests, PCT's etc. you score 5 points.

4. Servicing on any rally scores 5 points for each rally whether restricted, national or international.

## 5. Trackrod Trophy Donor Mr. J. Wilson All Round Club Monber

Only Trackrod Motor Club organised events to count for this award. These score as follows:-

Autotests Driver - 5 points for every event.

P.C.T. Driver and passenger - 5 points for each event.

5 points every event for all including Clork of Marshaling

Organising Events 15 points for all events.

Rallies Just Trackrod events to count.

Scoring is same system as ANCC Rallies on Percentage in class.

## 10. <u>Lloyds Special Stage Rally Trophy</u> <u>Donor Mr. & Mrs. S.Lloyd</u>

Only Special Stage Rally events to count, except for single venue events.

Awarded to the driver who scores highest number of points on Special Stage events.

## 11. SPY 44 Tropht Donor Mr. & Mrs. C.R. Jackson

All round competitor.

## Eligibility

Competitors must be entered under Trackrod Motor Club or Team Trackrod. All events to count except ones organised by Trackrod Motor Club.

## Events to count

Autotest (Driver) Rally Cross (Driver) Sprints (Driver) P.C.T. (Driver) Hill Climbs (Driver) Rallies (Driver/Navigator)

Best 5 events to count with a minimum of 3 types of motor sport (as above). Competitions to be organised by clubs other than Trackrod.

Scoring based on ANCC rallies system.

## 14. Kyers Menorial Trophy Donor Philip Myers

## Bost Novice Award

Awarded to the most successful competitive newcomer to motor sport ever the year. All nominees will be looked at through the year and the Committee will decide who will have the award.

## 15. J.&.B. Trophy Donor Jin & Beryl Stoker

For the best Trackrod event of the year. This excludes rallies as there is usually a team to organise these. All events are looked at throughout the year and the Committee will decide who receives the award.

## 16. The Hunters Trophy Donors Ron & Linsey Mackinnon

This goes to the winners of the Treasure Hunt Championship for that year.

## 17. Willie Wonka Trophy Donor A good friend of John Westnereland

This trophy goes to the winners of the annual Indoor Rally Chiship.

## 18. Single Venue Stage Rally Trophy - Crest Motels Trophy

Awarded to the highest scoring driver on single venue events only, with a maximum of eight events to count.

Scoring same system as ANCC events - percentage of class.

## 19. Scalextric Trophy

Awarded to the winner of the Championship

## 20. Stage Navigators Trophy Gordon Jefferson Trophy

Awarded to the highest scoring co-driver on Stage events. Maximum eff 8 events to count, and must have a minimum of 2 multi venue stage rallies.

Same scoring system as ANCC events - percentage of class.

## Hunters Trephy

Over the past few years we have run a treasure hunt championship for the Hunters Trophy, but due to the very poor response last year and the year before, I have, as stated at the end of last season, decided not to run the championship this year.

Movever, to keep the trophy in circulation, and to give you all soutthing to aim for from the 1st of June to the end of December, any clubnight ' event involving the use of your car to compete will qualify for the trophy.

Events to qualify will be :-

Clubnight PCT, autotest, Sportonoggin, 12 car navigation events, treasure hunt (if anyone cares to organise one), Boxing day autotest.

Foints will be scored on your overall position per event on the same basis as the treasure hunt ch'ship and Indoor rally ch'ship. i.e. 1st 0/A 27 pts 2nd 0/A 21 pts /rd 0/A 16 pts etc. So that the organisers of these events are not left out of the chance to compete for the trophy, they will score 20 points for organising the event. Many event which requires marshals, marshals will gain 10 points.

None of these events, whether you organise or compete on them, will effect your normal points gained under the annual trophy system. This is entirely seperate and additional to all other trophies.

Come on guys and gals, here is a chance to widen your field with a trophy ... at the end, give it a go!


## Lambswool Pullovers

3). Roar engine-Rear wheel drive.






