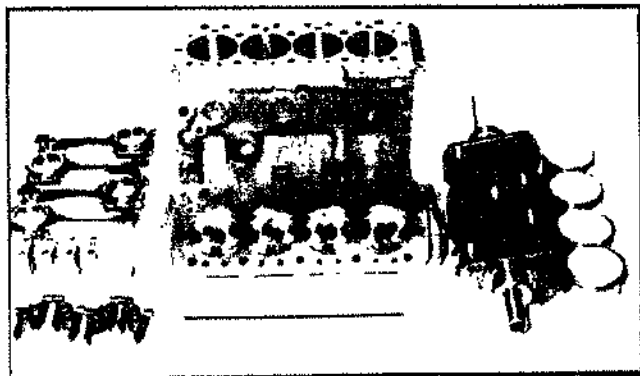

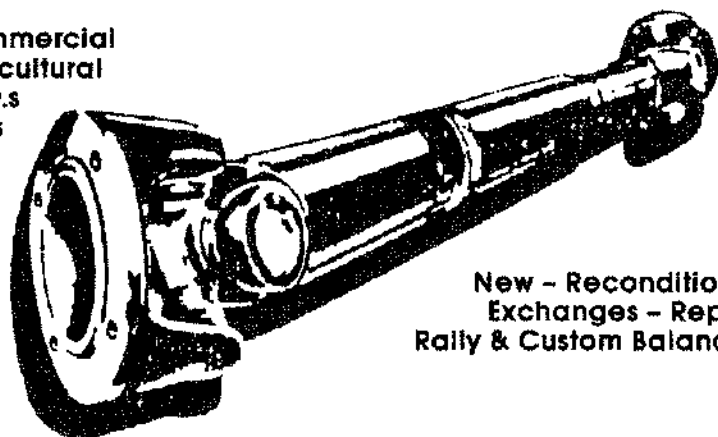

SEC'S PIECE

Just a few notes to keep you abreast of the latest moves by the RAC to make your motorsport safer, more tightly controlled, and therefore more expensive!

For 1986, for instance, the blue book will contain a regulation that all stage rally cars are fitted with mudflaps in the same way that rallycross vehicles are (Regulation QJ5(d)). Also required in 1986 in stage cars will be head restraints (QM13). There is also a reminder that crash helmets over 4 years old are not acceptable for motor sport competition.

The RACMSA have confirmed their plans for the "Clubmens" status of events, replacing the "Closed/Joint" status, and thus the need for all competitors (other than passengers

on a trial) to be licensed by the RAC. The above, plus many other items, are listed in the RAC "Club News" which I receive each month. Anyone, especially event organisers, who wishes to keep upto date on the details should ask for a sight of this publication. Finally, congratulations to the Costa team on another successful event, even if our own club's entries had an "off" night!! I think that the plaudits should go to Steve Hitchcock though; as he was approached at 1 hours notice to start his first ever rally, in car 89, with Tony Moore (10 miles rally experience). That they finished this tough event at all is very commendable, but to end up 33rd. O/A, 5th in a class of 30 odd, and best Trackrod crew, was really marvellous. Well done both of you!!
