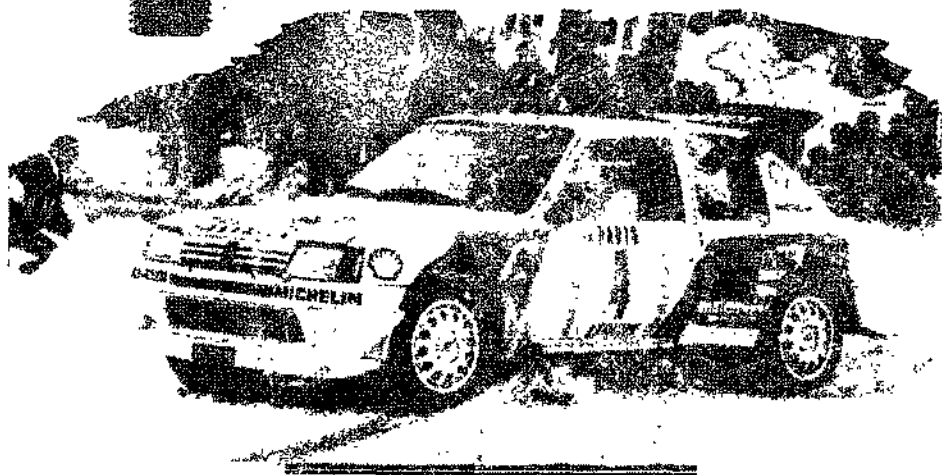

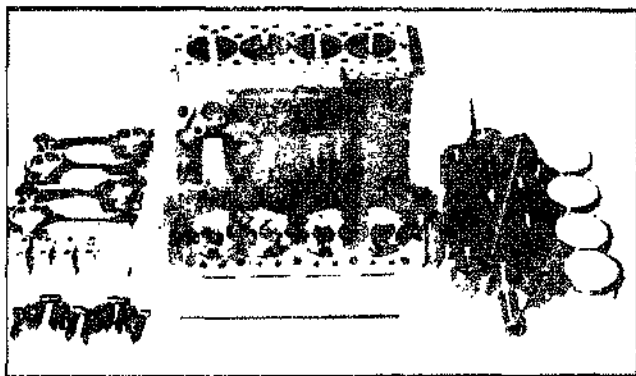

Thanks to the Dixons for an excellent event and to the three crews who took part for your support.

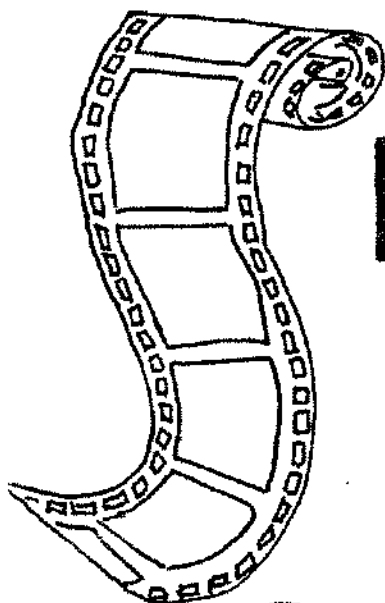
