And also there are some details on deals to the British Grand Prix and also some special deal on RAIN-EX, the stuff you put on your wirdscreen for dispelling water.


Don't forget that the ACM is on 2nd August and 1'm standing down so if anyone is interested in becoming the Editor please see any member of the committee.
