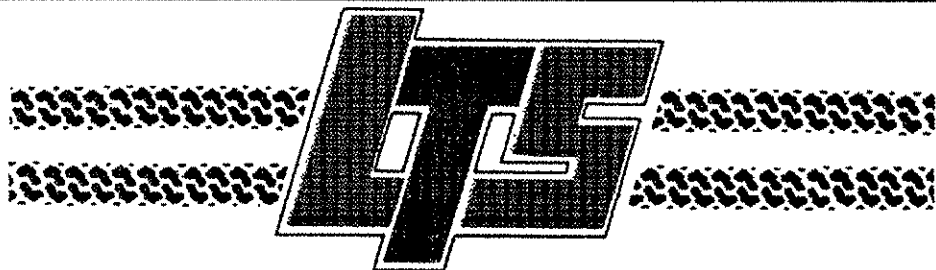

Also what happened to the rest of you all, who expressed interest, did you all sleep in or have you all got enough petrol cars, which by tradition is awarded to the last placed car.

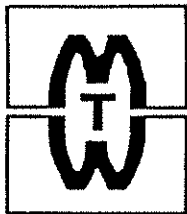

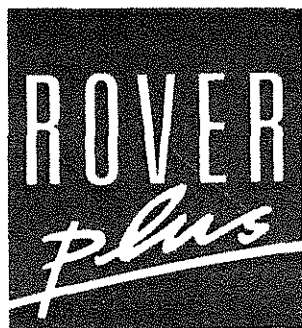
