



MANSELL - CHAMPION IN EXILE - continues...

Mansell's anger was understandable. Driving brilliantly, streets ahead of his nearest opponent, his team-mate, he was just a few points from winning the world championship he had coveted all his life. Yet behind the scenes his hated rival was tunnelling into the team with the specific aim of wresting from him the car he had worked hard to help perfect and the status that he had earned. Friends say he discussed retiring on the spot. It was then that Mansell, with Rosanne's (his wife) backing, decided to fight Prost: they'd both sacrificed much to get this far and they weren't going to walk away and leave him with the fruits of their labour.

At the Hungarian Grand Prix Mansell reopened negotiations with Frank Williams and later told friends that they had agreed terms: he would partner Prost in the team on equal terms, guaranteed by contract, and accept \$1.5m compensation. Mansell was returning to his home in the Isle of Man after the race: the papers would follow on Monday for signature.

"Nigel was reasonably happy that weekend", says an inside source. "A deal had been struck. He was angry for Riccardo but determined he would blow Prost off the track when the new season started. There was only one sticking point: in the new contract Frank Williams was proposing to drop the provision of three hotel rooms for Mansell and his family at all 16 Grand Prix, a matter of only a few thousand pounds. Mansell wanted at least one for him and Rosanne - as a gesture, if nothing else, of good faith".

Monday morning came and went and there was no sign of the legal documents. Later that day Mansell received a fax from Williams apologising for the delay and explaining that he had had to consult with Renault and Elf. Mansell called Williams. "You're not messing me about are you, Frank?" he asked. "No, just a few things that need sorting out", he replied.

Alarm bells were ringing but I thought maybe I was over-reacting and left it at that", Mansell told friends later. By Wednesday he was worried. He was tempted to cry off a golf tournament but he'd promised to play and decided it would take his mind off his suspicions. It was during the game that the body blow was struck.....
