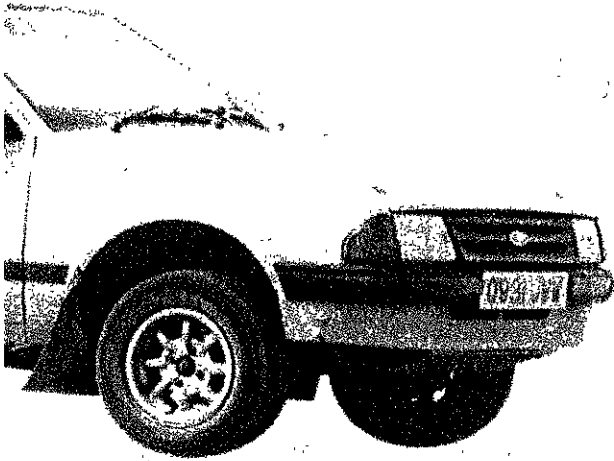

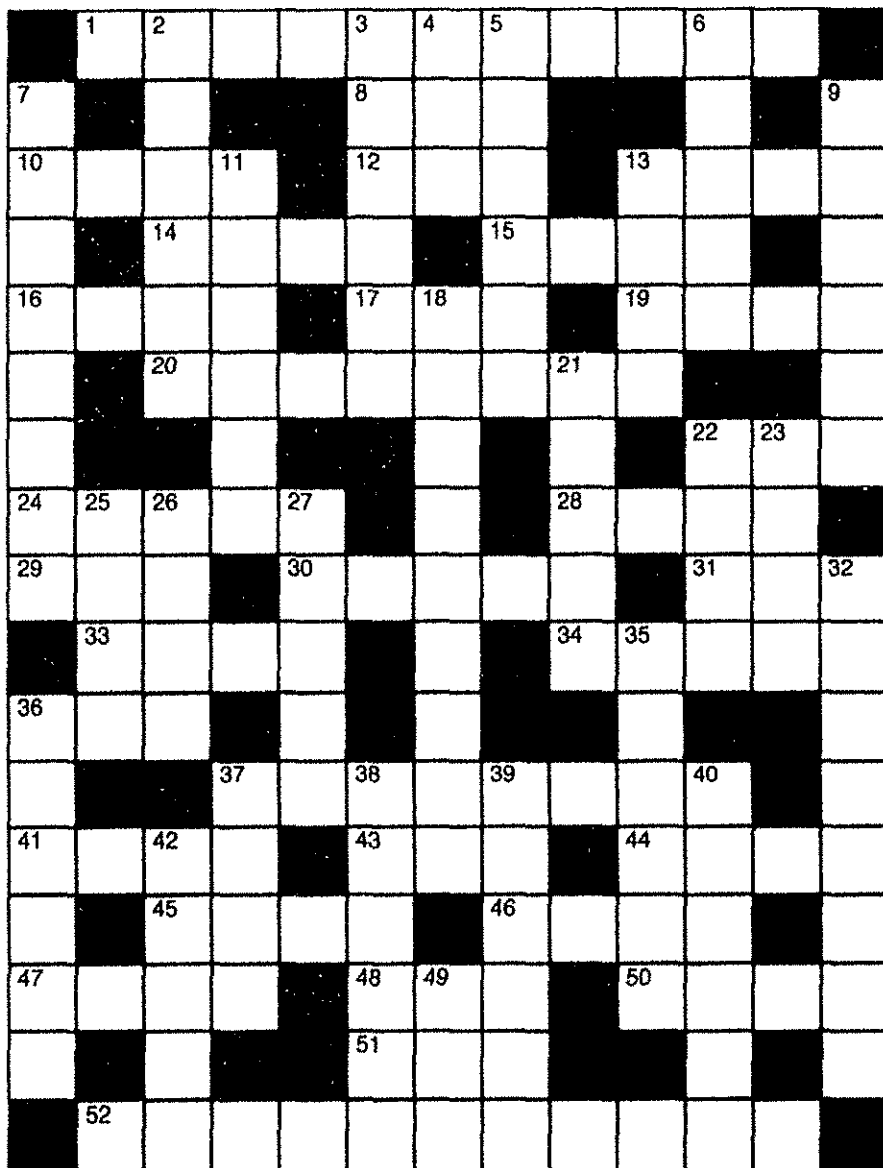

**30 JULY 1993**

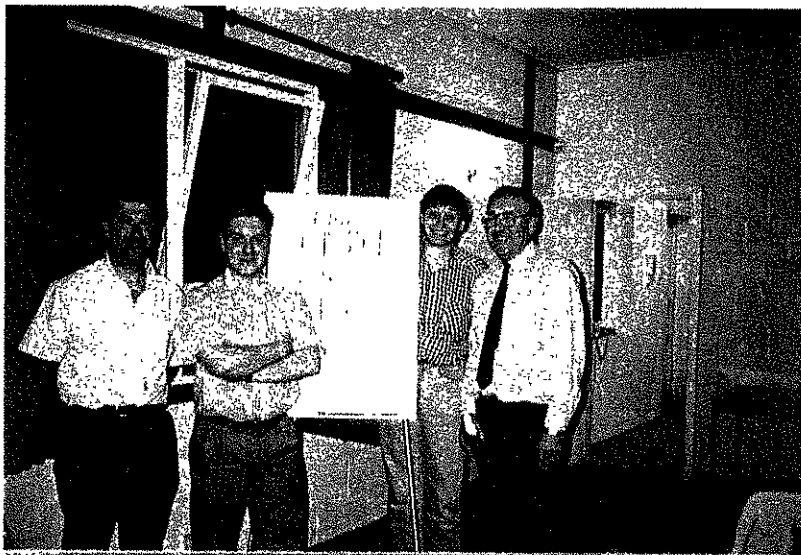
